► 01001 Christian Thought

We can find that through the history the mankind has always been living with the religion. The Christianity, which is founded on the life and teaching of Jesus of Nazareth, a historical figure (New Testament), on the religious and cultural background of Israeli people's faith in God (Old Testament), has played the leading role in the history for about 2000 years. The purpose of the course of Christian Thought is to lead students to enhance the comprehensive understanding of the world history(especially western one), its culture, and world view, and to accept as virtues worth for this and coming generation the truth, the love, and the service, which are the idea of foundation of this school, by studying on the world religions with the comparative methodology and on those main Christian virtues in depth.

► 03162 Thought and Expression

It is basically relevant to creative literacy that is a creative power to think out of the box, so that it is aimed to develop students' capacities to understand and utilize their thinking power.

► 03163 Theory of Sentence

This subject is concerned not only with the basic theory of writings, but also with the elevation of expression ability through the practice of writings.

► 02758 English

The objective of this class is to cultivate the indispensable ability to adapt to living in societies of the English speaking world in the future by practicing reading and speaking in English while introducing the culture and history of the English speaking world.

▶ **02759 Living English**

The objective of this course is to cultivate the students' necessary basic knowledge of English to be able to express themselves in daily life situations through spoken and written language and to cultivate English listening and pronunciation skills through classes taught by native speakers from the English speaking world.

▶ **02760 Service for Society**

Community service activities provide an opportunity to help others, promoting altruism.

▶ **02761 Bible and Man**

It is aimed to understand the Bible and its meaning in one's life. Reading the Bible together helps to extend the scope of truth and love and the view of the world as a Catholic student who respects life and loves humans.

▶ **02970 Modern Ethics and Man**

This course deals with emerging ethical issues of the time, including the nature and justification of moral principles, grounds for duties and the characteristic and standard of the good. The intellectual and ethical thinking of several social issues leads to the development of moral action. A mature ethical judgment helps to understand the modern society and nurture intellectuals.

▶ **03164 Life and Wisdom of Oriental**

This subject takes aim at the reflection of our own life through the wisdoms of oriental like Confucianism, Taoism, Buddhism.

▶ **03165 Myth and Philosophy**

This subject has aim at the reflection of our own life through various meanings of life, immersed in the myths of Greece and Rome.

▶ **02929 Culture and Religion**

Religion is ubiquitous throughout history, if beliefs in supernatural beings are considered to be a religion. With an understanding on diversity, this class is aimed to teach the universal meaning and rules of thinking through religious activities.

▶ **02974 Sex and Love**

This class is aimed to help students have a view of love and sex, which is critical in the growth process, by teaching sexual mores as well as how to understand love and sex psychologically, physically, physiologically, socially and culturally.

▶ **02975 Dignity of Man & Bioethics**

This course focuses on human dignity and life issues, ground in ethical questions raised by developments in medicine and science. They include biomedical and nursing ethics: sex and contraception; gene and human embryonic stem cell cloning; gene test before implantation; abortion; surrogate mother; euthanasia; brain death; organ transplantation; relationship between patients and doctors.

▶ **02976 Basic Etiquette as World Citizen: Lecture in English**

This class teaches necessary basic etiquette and manners in a globalized world, strengthening the national status in the international community.

▶ **02978 The Way to Korean Classic Literature**

We will study the heritage of Korean classical literature which are formed after ancient times. We can raise the good eye to see the human being and the society, cultivates.

▶ **02979 Theory and Appreciation of Literature**

We will study the important authors and the works of Korean current literature and theory of current literature from this subject. We will search about literature and the society, life of the human being.

▶ **02980 Tradition and Thoughts of Korean Literature**

We will observe the tradition of Korean literature from ideological viewpoint, but specially search the recognition and the works of the author together. Also recognize about literature and life deeply.

▶ **02981 Literature and Cinema**

We can search the interrelationship of literature and image art from this subject. And widen understands about life and time and culture.

▶ **02773 The Way to Sino-Korean**

We can raise the Sino-Korean capability to understand the major field of studies. And we can take out classic atmosphere of the Orient learns and cultivate our personality.

▶ **02982 General History of Korea**

This class is aimed at helping students understand various subjects politics, economy, culture and development of Korea history from ancient times to modern times.

▶ **02983 Heroes and Thoughts of Korean History**

We can study those who remain great trace of Korean history and observe their thought and life.

▶ **03166 Korean Modern Philosophical Thoughts**

We could take a view of the flows and the features of various thoughts, such as Donghak Movement, The Enlightenment Thought, Religious Thought, Nationalism, Capitalism, Communism, and Western Thought in Modern Korea.

▶ **03167 Korean Political Thoughts**

We could have a correct understanding about political ideas and forms through inspecting Korean political thoughts historically.

▶ **02986 Reading on Korean literary Classics**

We will study the Korean classics which expresses literature, history and ideology from this subject. And we will recognize the correct value of the width of the consciousness and life will be set up.

▶ **02987 History of International Exchange between Korea & China & Japan**

Through inspecting international exchanges between Korea, China, and Japan historically, we could understand their flows and directions that help us become cosmopolitans who know the importance of the straight international exchanges.

▶ **02995 The Way to History World Culture**

This course introduces different historical views and how to understand and analyze the peak and valley of Eastern and Western cultures from a comprehensive perspective.

▶ **02988 Business Administration in ordinary life**

Business management techniques have increasingly been used in different sectors, including government, school and household. This class is aimed to promote a rational decision-making process through applying business management techniques in ordinary life.

▶ **02989 Feminism: Happy Woman & Man**

The glass ceiling still remains, despite the advancement and empowerment of women's rights so far. Both men and women cannot truly be happy until the glass ceiling is broken.

▶ **01109 The Introduction to Human Relation**

People's happiness and success may depend on how desirable relationship they keep with others. This is because many people prefer to live forming relationships among others than to live alone. In this course, participants learn forming and maintaining desirable relationships; and study the characteristics of various types of relationships and the effective skills in communications.

▶ **02991 World Literature and Love**

This class is aimed to provide students with basic literature knowledge by teaching selective world literature works by writer, theme, content and its meaning in literature history.

▶ **03168 Cinema and Eastern Philosophy**

This subject introduces the general trend of the Eastern philosophy through cinema, in order to reflect the roots of today's thoughts.

▶ **02993 Cinema and Western Philosophy**

This course introduces essential topics of Western philosophy and its relationship with politics, history, religion, arts, morals and science, helping students have a critical and creative point of view.

▶ **02994 Logic and Critical Thinking**

This course is aimed to improve critical, rational and analytical thinking by teaching logical thinking.

▶ **02977 Life & Folklore of Traditional Society**

This course is aimed to recognize our way of life and the identity as a Korean, by teaching our tradition and folk customs.

▶ **02785 Medical Care System and Field**

The research aims to comprehensively investigate the development, organization, medical service, financial support, management, and productivity function, helping understand healthcare systems.

▶ **02996 Politics in the 21th**

This class is aimed to understand political interests and its power game at home and abroad in the 21st century, suggesting the right course to reconstruct international political relations in the right way.

▶ **02997 Sociology in the 21th**

This course focuses on different views to understand and interpret different variables of social changes. With the understanding, variables for the good society are provided.

▶ **02998 Laws in ordinary life**

As almost every part of life is intrinsically relevant to laws and regulations, this class teaches essential legal knowledge, particularly about property, taxes, consumer rights and domestic relations law.

▶ **02789 The Introduction to Psychology**

This is an introduction to psychology in general, to understand and examine a range of theories and phenomena. It covers mainly the followings; human development, motivation, emotion, personality, mental health, learning, cognition and intelligence and social behaviour.

▶ **03000 Leadership paradigm in the 21th**

This class focuses on the nature and concept of leadership and analyzes leadership theories and studies based on its characteristics, actions, circumstances, introducing recent leadership paradigms. In addition, it teaches necessary leadership techniques and knowledge by applying them to a real situation, improving a capability to build a leadership paradigm suitable for the 21st century.

▶ **01040 Basic Multimedia Practice**

This class teaches the basic concept of multimedia, its composition, comprehensive theories on application and various multimedia tools as well as has practical training.

▶ **01041 Basic Internet Application**

This class is aimed to get a grip with standard Web languages and relevant scripts, achieving a capability to organize a project with them.

▶ **02933 Basic Elementary Programming**

This class teaches how to use computer programming languages with which logical ideas can be expressed.

▶ **03001 Information Technology and Future Research**

In this course, we teach the development process, importance, and future direction of information technologies that would be keynote of modern societies, also teach medical information technologies, health information technologies, environmental information technologies, management information technologies for future societies. Students cultivate their abilities that predict the future and prepare the knowledge and professionalism that can lead future societies.

▶ **03002 Basic Mathematics**

Mathematics is one of the primary subjects to enhance students' numerical capability, logical thinking that are prerequisite to study natural sciences. This class is aimed to fully grasp the basic concept of differential and integral calculus, using such an understanding to study further.

▶ **03003 Basic Physics**

This class is an introduction to the basic laws of physics. These laws explain the natural phenomenon we

experience everyday. Simple reasoning and analytical methods will be used to solve problems. Topics such as motion, force, work, gravity, and momentum will be discussed. The vocabulary used in physics will be translated and explained.

▶ **02852 The Introduction to Physics (Lecture in English)**

This class is an introduction to the basic laws of physics. These laws explain the natural phenomenon we experience everyday. Simple reasoning and analytical methods will be used to solve problems. Topics such as motion, force, work, gravity, and momentum will be discussed. The vocabulary used in physics will be translated and explained.

▶ **03004 Basic Biology**

This class focuses on the origin of life, its building blocks, metabolism, genetics and reproduction.

▶ **03005 Basic Chemistry**

This course analyzes natural phenomena from a chemical point of view and teaches basic chemistry.

▶ **03006 Basic Geology**

This course is aimed to understand changes on the planet by teaching basic knowledge on the ocean, geology, astronomy and meteorology.

▶ **03007 Basic Western Medicine**

This course teaches the limit and usefulness of western medicine, identifying its identity.

▶ **03008 Basic Oriental Medicine**

This course teaches the limit and usefulness of oriental medicine, identifying its identity.

▶ **03009 Basic Ecology: Harmony between Nature and Man**

This course addresses emerging green issues with the meaning of ecosystem, pollution and afforestation projects, raising awareness about the importance of environment.

▶ **03010 Basic History of Science & Technology**

This course teaches the history of science and technology, understanding its social and cultural role.

▶ **03169 Creativity in Ordinary Life**

The world keeps changing at an unbelievable speed, leaving us at loss to predict the future society. In general, Creativity is essential to individual person and the society. Creative ability can be developed by education or training. We can all become a creative person that can think creatively and produce creative products if we put an effort with some orientation.

Major topics: Creative theory(personality, cognitive, press, products), creative thinking skills & divergent thinking program, creative assessments, and creative achievements.

▶ **02801 Health and Wellness**

Health and Wellness is an understanding and practicing of wellness, which can change the lifestyle for a healthy life, which is a foundation for a happy life. This class is about health and wellness, physical strength, effective exercise, proper eating habits, effective weight control, and proper athletic regimen,

etc (an hour per week). This class leads to a healthy and vigorous life through physical training, such as tennis, which will provide the ability to improve the quality of life.

▶ **02802 Bowling**

Bowling is played in 100 countries in the world. Bowling is a public sport that has 50 million manias in America, and 5 million manias in South Korea. Bowling is popular because it releases stress, which is a foundation of many diseases. Also people can control their weight, and exercise with it. Students can enjoy bowling with their families for their lifetimes. This class provides an education of Bowling is history, facility, rules, basic theory, and skills. This class helps basic students achieve higher than an intermediate level through playing real games.

▶ **03170 Summer Sports**

When selecting ocean sports, such as scuba diving, windsurfing, and yachting, you will learn the equipment's name, assembly, and safety rules for ocean activities based on swimming. This class teaches an organized program of theory and practical training. Not only can students enjoy themselves, but they also gain teaching ability through this class.

▶ **03171 Golf**

This class teaches students how to swing precisely, and they can adapt themselves to a real game through practice. As they learn about what golf is, the requirements of basic play, method of practice range, preparation, and caution before getting on the golf course, the rules, manners and etiquette as well, students can learn theory and practical training through a lecture based on actual technique at the same time.

▶ **03014 Ski**

This class is about the special quality, history, and basic function of skiing as a winter sport, which is done in nature. This class focuses on skiing as a lifelong sport, and teaches intensively during winter when there are good facilities and weather conditions. The main lecture is about basic skills how to get on and off the skis, how to stop, and fall, including how to descend on low slopes, and turn. Skiing requires endurance, boldness, and quickness, so this class also focuses on improving basic physical strength.

▶ **03015 Tennis**

The class will provide with an education on the basic skills of tennis, including grip, posture, ground stoke, volley, smash, and serve. Students will be educated about the basic skills and rules of the game, and the class also will provide students knowledge of game skills, based on doubles game. The students will understand the principles and reasons of the basic skills and game strategies. This class will provide students with different etiquette and human relations skills in order to improve the quality of their game.

▶ **03016 Traditional Arts and Modern Arts**

This course is designed to understand Korean traditional paintings, dances, and operas, identifying the color of our tradition and comparing it with the modern trend.

▶ **03017 Odyssey of Aesthetics**

This course is to study the meaning, value and purpose of life through aesthetic education, helping students to realize that the understanding of arts makes life more beautiful.

▶ **03018 Cinema and Arts**

This course is aimed to critically analyze the characteristics of motion picture and its social meanings as well as film as a cultural product, and to develop insights to interpret its contextual languages.

▶ **03019 Mass and Culture**

The public have only consumed culture passively, rather than actively creating it. This course is to take a closer look at the mass culture in order to help them become active participants.

▶ **03020 The Way to History and Appreciation of Music**

This course focuses on representative styles and composers by era as well as listening to the music.

▶ **02990 Interesting Art Therapy**

Interesting Art Therapy is a course that assists students to recognize and overcome people's psychological problems while using various types of art media such as drawing and art crafts etc. to express their experience and emotions.

▶ **03022 The Adventure to World Culture**

This course is to promote a better understanding on the lives and institutions of foreign countries by exploring world cultures with the focus on experience.

▶ **03155 Meditation Journey in search of the Self**

This is both an academic and practical course. The students will read about the various meditation traditions throughout the world and have the opportunity to practice several of them. Classes will be divided into two parts, discussion of reading materials, and in-class meditation practice. Requirements are daily meditation, keeping a meditation journal, reading of materials for class, and class discussion of readings and meditation experience. Class will be taught in both English and Korean.

▶ **02218 Drill for TOEIC 1**

The fundamental objective of this class is not only to help students prepare for the TOEIC exam but also to expand the students' English vocabulary and understanding of structure; and extend their reading and listening skills necessary for the TOEIC exam, studying abroad, and finding employment in the English speaking world or in related fields through practicing focused language.

▶ **02219 Drill for TOEIC 2**

This class is not only a continuation of the Practice for TOEIC 1 course but also it is a level higher than that course. It extends the students' reading and listening skills necessary for the TOEIC exam, studying abroad, and finding employment in the English speaking world.

▶ **03023 Sightseeing French**

This course, which is for students who want to learn French for travel to France, helps students learn pronunciation, practical language for travel and basic grammar and understand French culture and society.

▶ **03024 Sightseeing German**

This course, which is for students who want to learn German for travel to Germany, helps students learn

practical language for travel, for example, pronunciation and basic grammar, and understand German culture and society.

▶ **02427 Advanced English Conversation**

This is a unique and ingenious continuing program that teaches students how to correctly use intermediate and advanced English expressions in diverse situations and topics used in everyday life. Additionally, the objective of this course is generally to use English skills in order to have the command of the ability to communicate face to face with foreigners without any psychological burden.

▶ **02810 Practical English for Career**

This course, which is for students who want to learn English for travel to Great Brittan or the United States of America, helps students learn practical language for travel, for example, pronunciation and basic grammar, and understand British and American culture and society.

▶ **03172 Practical Japanese for Career**

This course, which is for students who want to learn Japanese for travel to Japan, helps students learn practical language for travel, for example, pronunciation and basic grammar, and understand Japanese culture and society.

▶ **03173 Practical Chinese for Career**

This course, which is for students who want to learn Chinese for travel to China, helps students learn practical language for travel, for example, pronunciation and basic grammar, and understand Chinese culture and society.

▶ **03028 Basic Chinese**

This course cultivates basic Chinsese skills through practicing Chinese listening, speaking, reading and writing.

▶ **03029 Intermediate Chinese**

This course develops a command of intermediate Chinese skills by practicing listening, speaking, reading and writing.

▶ **02813 Advanced Chinese**

This course develops a command of Chinese skills through practicing Chinese listening, speaking, reading and writing.

▶ **03030 Basic Japanese**

This course cultivates basic Japanese skills through practicing Japanese listening, speaking, reading and writing.

▶ **03031 Intermediate Japanese**

This course develops a command of Japanese skills through practicing Japanese listening, speaking, reading and writing.

▶ **02816 Advanced Japanese**

This course develops a command of Japanese skills through practicing Japanese listening, speaking, reading and writing.

Teaching courses

▶ **01080 Introduction to Education**

An introduction to education to examine its essential function and characteristics in general. This course provides students opportunities to analyze educational phenomena in various academic point of views which will lead students to develop their ability to judge rationally on overall educational issues.

▶ **01079 Philosophy and History of Education**

This outlines and examines the philosophical and historical foundation of education. In particular, it assists on developing the ability to search for ideal Korean education, focusing on educational trends and philosophies related to Korea.

▶ **01980 Educational Psychology**

This course is concerned with understanding various educational problems that teachers may face in educational scenes, from psychological point of view. It also develops the students' ability to learn and apply theories and analyses to solve the problems.

▶ **01075 Sociology of Education**

This course introduces students to basic knowledge of Sociology of Education and helps developing ability to understand and analyze the relationship between educational issues and society.

▶ **03032 Educational Evaluation**

This course focuses on understanding the meaning, role and evaluation of educational evaluation, and on debating on criterion-referenced and norm-referenced evaluations. It is also concerned with understanding the characteristics of diagnostic and formative evaluations as well as the characteristics of the measurement. It develops student's ability to analyze the problems including validity, reliability and objectivity, and learn to apply this in the educational situation.

▶ **02187 Educational Methods & Educational Technology**

This course explores educational methods based on teaching and learning theories; and the students will learn history and theories of educational technology. It involves learning various applicable media such as computer and multimedia in educational scene as well as developing the ability to utilize them.

▶ **03036 Practical Affairs of the Teaching Profession**

This course assists students to acquire necessary knowledge and skills to carry out teaching profession, such as 'teaching ethics', 'social change and education', 'student culture', 'class management and student guidance, in addition to 'teaching.'

▶ **03035 Understanding of the Gifted and Exceptional Children**

This course is concerned with understanding a variety of characteristics such as cognitive, affective and behavioural ones, in students who are in need of special education; e.g. gifted children, children with

learning difficulties, and children with behavioural and emotional difficulties. It also provides opportunities for students to seek and acquire the knowledge and skills that are effective in teaching, through curriculum, teaching method and media which are suitable for these special children.

► **03038 Educational Service Activity**

This activity develops student's quality and ability in familiarizing locality and in practical management, by offering opportunities for them to carry out teacher's role as a teacher-aid in actual educational situation. The student teachers will broaden their views on education through teaching experience and voluntary activities in kindergartens, primary schools, middle and high schools, special schools and social educational institutes that offer different majors.

► **02188 Educational Administration and Educational Management**

This course outlines the changes in theories of educational administration; and also focuses on the topics such as educational system, school organization, staffing and school management to cover a range of perspectives includes personal relations, leadership, and teacher-student interaction. The students learn to apply in actual educational management.
