▶ **01142 Introduction to Nursing science**

This course, 01142 Introduction to Nursing Discipline, introduces the beginning nursing student to professional concepts and disciplinary knowledge as well as attitude with combination between nursing science and philosophy. An overview of the nursing profession's historical development, including western history of nursing and Korean history of nursing will be discussed. In this course the student will explore nursing profession, the role of the professional nurse, and the professional fields regarding nursing care.

▶ **02831 Nursing Terminology**

This subject deals with the understanding of basic nursing field and major subject. It also aims to study the origin of a professional nursing terminology and commentary for effective communication and nursing record in healthcare field.

▶ **03033 Anatomy and Practice**

This subject provides a basic concept of the gross and microscopic anatomy of the human body. So it is composed of the anatomy of digestive, respiratory, cardiovascular, urogenital, nervous and skeletal system, and sensory organs.

▶ **01174 Physiology**

In this course, students will acquire a comprehensive theoretical foundation of phenomena in human physiologic functions. So, this subject consists of organization of human body, cells and their function, movement and support, coordination and control, circulation and body defense, energy supply and use.

▶ **02192 Human Relationship and Interpersonal Communication**

This subject deals with the studies of theory and practice concerning the warm-hearted, empathy, regard, concreteness, faithfulness, confronting, self promote, and the immediacies of a relationship.

▶ **01195 Pharmacology**

This subjects examines the pharmacological principles of drugs used in therapeutics. It deals with the site, molecular mechanism of action, pharmacokinetics and major side effects of drugs categorized by systems. And provides the basis for the rational understanding of applied clinical pharmacology and therapeutics of drugs affecting these systems.

▶ **01650 Pathology**

This Subject is to study the pathogenesis of human disease across the life span. So it is composed of pathological aspect of cell injury, cardiovascular disorder inflammation, immune disorder, and neoplasm.

▶ **01164 Microbiology**

This subject is designed to give the students an understanding of fundamental principles of microorganisms related to human diseases. Topics include the classification, structure, metabolism, growth, investigation techniques and controls in various pathogenic microorganisms as well as immune responses in human body.

▶ **01135 Nursing and Nutrition**

This subject provides both a strong research based and a person centered approach to the application of nutrition in human health. It consists of introduction to human nutrition(CHO, protein, lipid, vitamin, mineral, and energy balance, etc.), and clinical nutrition(diet therapy according to the diseases).

▶ **02230 Community Health Nursing I**

This subject deals with knowledge, skills, and attitudes to understand community health nursing and to solve the community problems. It studies about main concepts, historical review, theories of health and community health nursing, health management system (health policy, health delivery system, medical security system, and primary health care), and environmental health.

▶ **01781 Fundamentals of Nursing I**

This subject designed to provide basic concepts in health care, principles of nursing practice for professional nursing, focusing on the study of basic human needs, especially concepts in health assessment and basic nursing skills of safety, and hygiene.

▶ **01782 Fundamentals of Nursing Practice I**

This subject designed to provide primary nursing care skills with a laboratory unit. Focuses on health assessment and basic nursing skills of safety, hygiene including asepsis.

▶ **03034 Counseling Theory & Practice**

The students possess concrete strategies and skills to understand and change human behaviors through psychoanalysis, person-centered therapy, transactional analysis, behavioral therapy, and reality therapy.

▶ **01961 Oriental Nursing**

This subject cultivates the student's ability to care for individuals with having wholistic basic needs in the oriental integrating approach. In this course, Students will acquire the knowledge and skill about oriental medical treatment, care of health, and complementary therapy.

▶ **03174 Discipline of Health Education**

This subject is to analyze relationship of health problem to human behavior, and to study the way to change the human behavior related to health toward optimal status of health. It deals with principle of health education, its characteristics depending on the types of community, specific methods in health education implementation.

▶ **02232 Pediatric Nursing I**

This subject cultivates students' ability of caring for the well children, high risk newborn and the family. So it includes the normal physical, mental and psychological development of well children and the health problems of high risk newborn.

▶ **02434 Maternity Nursing I**

This subject cultivates the student's ability to care for women in pregnancy, childbirth and postpartum periods. It includes an introduction to maternity nursing, the reproductive system, family planning, pregnancy, childbirth, and postpartum care.

▶ **01146 Health Assessment and Practice**

This subject aims to develop the critical thinking power that assesses health problem of clients. The student receives how to take histories and how to perform physical examinations through lecture and practice.

▶ **03039 Nursing Process and Critical Thinking**

This subject aims to develop the critical thinking power that contributes to problem solving abilities. The student receives an introduction to nursing process, a writing method of nursing diagnosis and an application of nursing process to various nursing settings.

▶ **01783 Fundamentals of Nursing II**

This subject designed to provide basic nursing care for professional nursing, focusing on the study of basic human needs, especially concepts in health assessment and basic nursing skills of oxygenation, exercise, sleep, nutrition, and elimination.

▶ **01784 Fundamentals of Nursing Practice II**

This subject designed to provide primary nursing care skills with a laboratory unit. Focuses on health assessment and basic nursing skills of oxygenation, exercise and sleep, nutrition and elimination. Continuation of Basic Nursing and Laboratory I

▶ **02231 Community Health Nursing II**

This subject deals with more practical skills and attitudes on health needs and community problems in changing environmental situation. Emphasis is on the understanding of basic concepts on community health nursing, community nursing, public health system, community health nursing service, maternal & child health, family planning, and industrial health.

▶ **02435 Epidemiology and Health Promotion**

This subject aims to develop knowledge, skills and attitudes to understand health problems of the population and to plan a health promotion. It deals with the causes of disease occurrence, natural history & preventive level of disease, health condition, measurement of disease level, descriptive & analytic epidemiology, epidemic survey, disease management, school health, and health promotion.

▶ **01175 Adult Nursing I**

This subject concerns the caring for people with medical-surgical problems. The student receives an introduction to adult nursing, nursing process for clients with fluid and electrolyte imbalance, acid-base imbalance, alterations in digestive & elimination and the renal system.

▶ **02239 Adult Nursing Practice I**

This subject aims to develop the caring abilities for adults with acute and chronic health problems in various clinical settings. Emphasis is on the competency in nursing assessment and intervention and of basic nursing skills.

▶ **01191 Pediatric Nursing Practice I**

This subject cultivates students' ability to practice the caring for the children with acute health problems and the family. So it is composed of clinical practicum in the pediatric ward to solve the children's acute health problems by using the nursing process.

▶ **03178 Community Health Nursing Practice I**

This subject aims to develop the skills understanding public health resource and evaluating tasks. It deals

with the organization and function of health center, roles and activities of public health nurse and health team.

▶ **01137 Nursing Ethics**

The focus of this course, 01137 Nursing Ethics, is to explore the ethical dimensions of nursing care in contemporary society. The course begins by examining personal and professional values including code of ethics while also exploring the impact of society in decision making as a profession. Ethical theories and decision making model in ethical dilemma are examined and provide a basis of analysis of ethical issues confronting nursing practice.

▶ **01202 Psychiatric Nursing I**

This course will provide basic knowledge, skills and attitude for helping to understand human mental health life. Therefore this class will generally approach to mental health, understanding of human being, therapeutic environment client, family mental health environment, understanding of mental health, and therapeutic interrelationship. Also this course will begin with applying the nursing process of schizophrenia and the other mental disorder as the particular and for the contents of study.

▶ **02233 Pediatric Nursing II**

This subject cultivates students' ability of caring for the children with health problems and the family, so it includes the care of children with acute and chronic health problems.

▶ **01157 Maternity Nursing II**

This subject cultivates the student's ability to care for women with reproductive health problem. In this course, Students will acquire the knowledge, skill, and values needed for caring with postpartal complication, menopause, infertility, menstrual problem, and neoplasm of the reproductive organ problems.

▶ **01833 Fundamentals of Nursing Practice in Clinical Fields**

This subject aims to develop the caring ability to practice basic nursing skills. In this course, Students will acquire the basic nursing skills in medical-surgical and intensive care unit with clinical instructor.

▶ **03175 Program Development and Evaluation In Health Care**

This subject is to develop the programs for effective implementation of health education, and to study a way of evaluating outcomes of health education. It deals with basic theory and methods required to development for health care program, and a variety of its evaluation methods.

▶ **02234 Adult Nursing II**

This subject concerns the caring for person with medical-surgical problems. The student receives an introduction to operative nursing, nursing process for client with alteration in respiratory, endocrine and musculo-skeletal system.

▶ **01205 Psychiatric Nursing Practice I**

This course will offer the experiences of practice for having basic and scientific skills and attitude to integrate and adapt theoretical basic knowledge to people with physical or mental problems in a psychiatric ward.

▶ **01159 Maternity Nursing Practice I**

This subject cultivates the student's ability to practice caring for women in pregnancy, childbirth and postpartum periods in various clinical settings. It is composed of clinical practice in a delivery room, an obstetrics ward and a gynecological ward to treat women's health problems in the nursing process.

▶ **01192 Pediatric Nursing Practice II**

This subject cultivate students' ability to practice the caring for well newborn, high risk newborn and the family. So it is composed of clinical practicum in the nursery and the newborn intensive care unit to solve the well newborn care and the high risk newborn's health problems by using the nursing process.

▶ **01216 Community Health Nursing Practice II**

This subject aims to develop student`s ability to help the population in community maintain, promote, and manage their health. It consists of field practice, where the students understand health problems of the population in community, and learn how to solve these problems in community.

▶ **01184 Adult Nursing Practice II**

This subject aims to develop the caring ability for adults with acute and chronic health problems in various clinical settings. Emphasis is on the competency in nursing process, intervention of preoperative, intraoperative and postoperative nursing skills.

▶ **01126 Nursing Management I**

This course, 01126 Nursing Management I, provides the fundamental understanding in preparing the professional nurse to commit to a leadership and/or management role for effectively responding upon various needs of nursing organization and to solve the problems related to nursing management. This course includes nursing management concept and related theories, operational management of nursing units, nursing unit planning, organization and human resource management in nursing.

▶ **03177 Educational Methods for Health Care**

This subject is to understand ways of application related to health education, knowledge of media and its utilization. It deals with a client and its characteristics for health education program, health education method depending on educational environment, and selection as well as use of educational media.

▶ **03176 Creative Problem Based Learning and Practice in Nursing**

This subject is to study not only a method of problem-based learning(PBL), but creative problem solving process in order to enforce competency in problem solving related to nursing care at bed-side. The student receives principle of problem-based learning and creative problem solving theory, and is undertaken the practice for identifying caring problem and exploring creative ideas for taking care for individual patient with problem-based learning combined creative thinking training based on nursing situational cases.

▶ **01203 Psychiatric Nursing II**

This course will have students realize the importance of psychiatric nursing in various mental disorder patient care, mental therapy activities and developmental growth. Also this class will focused on bringing up basic knowledge and attitude for understanding community mental health environment, identifying into multidimensional problems of mentally ill person, adapting psychiatric nursing process to the problem and

finally solve it.

▶ **02436 Nursing Management II**

This course, 02436 Nursing Management II, provides in depth knowledge of nursing management for preliminary nursing manager as well as nurse leader to effectively respond upon various needs of nursing organization and to solve the problems related to nursing management. This course includes human resource management of nursing, leadership, quality management, legal aspects in nursing management and nursing marketing.

▶ **01161 Maternity Nursing Practice II**

This subject cultivates the student's ability to practice caring for women with reproductive health problem in clinical settings. It is composed of clinical practice in a gynecological ward to treat women's health problems in the nursing process.

▶ **01194 Pediatric Nursing Practice III**

This subject cultivate students' to practice the caring for the children with severe and chronic health problems and the family. So it is composed the clinical practicum in the pediatric ward to solve the children's severe and chronic problems by using the nursing process.

▶ **01179 Adult Nursing III**

This subject deals with the caring for person with medical-surgical problems. It is composed of the alterations and nursing cares in cardiovascular, blood, and nervous system.

▶ **01186 Adult Nursing Practice III**

This subject aims to develop the caring abilities for adults with critically ill in intensive care units settings. Emphasis is on the competency in nursing assessment and intervention of advanced nursing skills. Nursing process for adult patients who have problems with fluid and electrolyte balance, gastro-intestinal and endocrine and as well as respiratory disorders.

▶ **01204 Psychiatric Nursing III**

This subject is to identify importance of psychiatric nursing in human development stage, and to understand nursing client with disease, suffers from violence and abuse, and psychiatric health environment in community. It deals with basic knowledge, attitude and technique for solving problems related to psychiatric nursing, implication of nursing process related to psychiatric caring, and ethical/legal responsibility of psychiatric nursing.

▶ **01206 Psychiatric Nursing Practice II**

This subject cultivates student's ability of caring for mentally-ill patients in psychiatric ward of General Hospital. so, It can help the student's clinical practice at psychiatric ward in order to resolve the mentally-ill patient problems based on basic principle by applying Psychiatric nursing process

▶ **01132 Nursing Research and Statistics**

In this course, students will study the process of writing basic nursing research proposal in the field of their interest and ctitique studies for application to the nursing practice. It consists of research methodology, design, measurement, data collection, sampling, statistics, and data analysis.

▶ **01963 Emergency Nursing and Practice**

This subject aims to develop the caring ability for person with emergent health problems. The student receives an introduction to emergency care and clinical practicum in an emergency room.

▶ **03037 Educational Action Practicum**

Participants will apply and practise the theory and knowledge they learned through teaching curriculum in overall, by observing and teaching in actual educational situation.

▶ **01977 Nursing and Law**

This course, 01966 Nursing and Law, is a study of professional knowledge and update information regarding a variety of the law for health protect and promotion.

▶ **01187 Adult Nursing Practice IV**

This subject aims to develop the caring abilities for adults with critically ill in intensive care units and orthopedic department. Emphasis is on the competency in nursing assessment and intervention of advanced nursing skills. Nursing process for adult patients who have problems with critically ill, and orthopedic disorders.

▶ **01744 Nursing Management Practice**

This course, 01744 Nursing Management Practice, provides practicum learning experience necessary for students to develop their competence in performing nursing administration tasks effectively and efficiently at a variety of health care organizations. Opportunities are provided to observe and apply concepts and principles of nursing administration in health care organizations and care delivery process at hospital fields.

▶ **01978 Nursing Seminar**

This subject attempts to integrate with major nursing subjects. It covers the overall review of major nursing subjects.

▶ **01207 Psychiatric Nursing Practice III**

This course focus on fostering the skills that can integrate and apply basic knowledge of psychiatric nursing to problems and the positive and professional attitude for development and rehabilitation of mental health in individual, families and communities wide.

▶ **02228 Oncology and Hospice Nursing**

This subject acquire the recent knowledge of oncology nursing and ability to holistic care for end of life patients. It includes theory of carcinogenesis, prevention of cancer, diagnosis of cancer, treatment of cancer, philosophy of hospice, and holistic care for end of life patients.

▶ **02229 Nursing Informatics**

This course, 0229 Nursing Informatics, introduces the student to the use of computer-based information management in health care, and provides a basic understanding of nursing information science and information system. Emphasis is on application that provide resources for clinical practice, education, communication, management, and research.

▶ **02227 Geriatric Nursing and Practice**

This subject provides basic concepts of physical, social, and psychological changes accompanying the human aging process, emphasizing the holistic view of nursing care for the health needs of the elderly.

▶ **02560 Elective Clinical Practice**

This course, 02560 Elective Clinical Practice, provides opportunities to acquire practical knowledge and skills of nursing care in specific care fields in which the students are interested for assessing a variety of nursing clients and planning, implementing, and evaluating nursing care interventions.

Teaching Courses

▶ **02230 Community Health Nursing I**

This subject deals with knowledge, skills, and attitudes to understand community health nursing and to solve the community problems. It studies about main concepts, historical review, theories of health and community health nursing, health management system (health policy, health delivery system, medical security system, and primary health care), and environmental health.

▶ **01781 Fundamentals of Nursing I**

This subject designed to provide basic concepts in health care, principles of nursing practice for professional nursing, focusing on the study of basic human needs, especially concepts in health assessment and basic nursing skills of safety, and hygiene.

▶ **01782 Fundamentals of Nursing Practice I**

The students possess concrete strategies and skills to understand and change human behaviors through psychoanalysis, person-centered therapy, transactional analysis, behavioral therapy, and reality therapy.

This course, 01126 Nursing Management I, provides the fundamental understanding in preparing the professional nurse to commit to a leadership and/or management role for effectively responding upon various needs of nursing organization and to solve the problems related to nursing management. This course includes nursing management concept and related theories, operational management of nursing units, nursing unit planning, organization and human resource management in nursing.

▶ **01205 Psychiatric Nursing Practice I**

This course will offer the experiences of practice for having basic and scientific skills and attitude to integrate and adapt theoretical basic knowledge to people with physical or mental problems in a psychiatric ward.

▶ **01175 Adult Nursing I**

This subject concerns the caring for people with medical-surgical problems. The student receives an introduction to adult nursing, nursing process for clients with fluid and electrolyte imbalance, acid-base imbalance, alterations in digestive & elimination and the renal system.

▶ **01201 Psychiatric Nursing I**

This course will provide basic knowledge, skills and attitude for helping to understand human mental health life. Therefore this class will generally approach to mental health, understanding of human being, therapeutic environment client, family mental health environment, understanding of mental health, and therapeutic interrelationship. Also this course will begin with applying the nursing process of schizophrenia and the other mental disorder as the particular and for the contents of study.

▶ **01963 Emergency Nursing and Practice**

This subject aims to develop the caring ability for person with emergent health problems. The student receives an introduction to emergency care and clinical practicum in an emergency room.

▶ **03037 Educational Action Practicum**

Participants will apply and practise the theory and knowledge they learned through teaching curriculum in overall, by observing and teaching in actual educational situation.

▶ **03038 Educational Service Activity**

This activity develops student's quality and ability in familiarizing locality and in practical management, by offering opportunities for them to carry out teacher's role as a teacher-aid in actual educational situation. The student teachers will broaden their views on education through teaching experience and voluntary activities in kindergartens, primary schools, middle and high schools, special schools and social educational institutes that offer different majors.

Special Course for Bachelor Degree

▶ **01836 Christian Thought**

The Christianity has helped human communities to be aware of the value of virtues such as truth, love, and dedication. The main educational purpose of this school is to cultivate the leaders of many fields of our society equipped with those virtues. With the same educational purpose, therefore, this course will focus on leading students to enhance their understanding of the Christianity and its teaching through various experiences of the Christian tradition

▶ **02782 The Introduction to Philosophy**

Philosophy refers to interests in Sophia. If knowledge relates to information on individual facts, Sophia is relevant to a comprehensive view on the world. Knowledge alone is not enough in philosophy. It interprets the whole world by defining possible reasons behind knowledge or relations between different knowledge.

▶ **02866 Health problem and Nursing I**

This subject deals with comprehensive understanding of community health nursing, and knowledge, skills and attitudes that are needed in the community fields. It includes comprehensive concepts of health, health delivery system, epidemiology, community-based nursing service.

▶ **02867 Health Problem and Nursing II**

This subject cultivates the student's ability to care for adult health problem in clinical settings. It consists of specific clinical populations and cares in terms of developmental level, specific health problems, and various health care settings.

▶ **02882 Health Assessment**

This subject aims to develop the critical thinking power that assesses health problem of clients. The student receives how to take histories and how to perform physical examinations through lecture and practice.

▶ **01762 Basic Nursing Science**

This subjects examines the pharmacological principles of drugs used in therapeutics. It deals with the site, molecular mechanism of action, pharmacokinetics and major side effects of drugs categorized by systems. And provides the basis for the rational understanding of applied clinical pharmacology and therapeutics of drugs affecting these systems. And this subject is designed to give the students an understanding of fundamental principles of microorganisms related to human diseases. Topics include the classification, structure, metabolism, growth, investigation techniques and controls in various pathogenic microorganisms as well as immune responses in human body.

▶ **02879 Living English I**

In this course, students learn English language used in the fields of health and medicine. The aim of the course is to cultivate competency in efficient mutual understanding in the fields of medicine and education in the English speaking world.

▶ **01045 Human beings and Environment**

Study on the understandings about the basic principles of various environments and our roles for the better people's environment and nature, and also general descriptions about various environmental pollutions on earth

▶ **01832 Informatics for Nursing**

This course, 01832 Informatics for Nursing, assist students in developing a basic knowledge and skills regarding information system, the structure and functions of computer, and the role and tasks of informatics specialist in nursing. Emphasis is on applications that provide resources for clinical practice, education, administration, and research with an understanding of nursing information standards, the use of internet and applied programs, e-Health/e-Nursing, and the security system of nursing informatics.

▶ **02868 Health Problem and NursingIII**

This subject cultivates the student's ability to care for adult health problem in clinical settings. It consists of specific clinical populations and cares in terms of developmental level, specific health problems, and various health care settings.

▶ **02869 Health Problem and Nursing IV**

This subject provides basic concepts of physical, social, and psychological changes accompanying the human aging process, emphasizing the holistic view of nursing care for the health needs of the elderly.

▶ **02820 Health Promotion and Health Education**

This subject aims to provide students with ability to understand related concepts of health promotion and to establish the promotion strategy. It also tries to make the students practice health education, which is the most widely used method for health promotion.

▶ **02883 Nursing Process and Critical Thinking**

This subject aims to develop the critical thinking power that contributes to problem solving abilities. The student receives an introduction to nursing process, a writing method of nursing diagnosis and an application of nursing process to various nursing settings.

▶ **01993 Living English II**

The object of this course is proficiency in English for mutual understanding of diverse patients in the field of nursing, and to be able to efficiently assess, diagnose and mediate problems between nurses and patients.

▶ **02193 Counselling Psychology**

This subject cultivates a student's ability to learn concrete strategy and skills for standpoint and changes for modern psychology, Psychoanalysis, which is important to skill of psychotherapy, person-centered therapy, transactional analysis and therapy, behavior therapy, and reality therapy.

▶ **02873 Community Mental Health Nursing**

This course will have students understand a role of mental health care nurses who identify and solve various mental health problem in modern society such as prevention, treatment, and rehabilitation in individual, family and community wide as a linked system. Therefore this class provide situation of community mental health nurses, recipient protecting action, and a modeling of role and responsibility as community mental health nurses. Also this class will offer basic knowledge, skills and attitude for care in different area such as in community, in school mental health ,in a public health center, in a mental health care center, in a residential area and in farming and fishing area and in different people such as children, adolescents, addicts, homeless, HIV patients, lawbreakers, and the old with mental illness.

▶ **02884 Health Problem and Nursing V**

This subject cultivates the student's ability to care for patients experiencing physical, psychological, social and spiritual stress in a end of life stage. So in this subject includes philosophy of hospice, understanding and attitude of death, and holistic care for end of life patients and families.

▶ **02446 Nursing Research**

In this course, students will study the process of basic nursing research. It consists of research methodology, design, measurement, data collection, sampling, and data analysis.

▶ **02885 Nursing Ethics**

This course, 02885 Nursing Ethics, prepares students to approach ethical dilemmas objectively with a through understanding of professional moral responsibility including philosophical basis of nursing ethics, ethical theory and principles, code of ethics for professional nurse, biomedical ethics. This course assists students to distinguish ethical from other kinds of issues in nursing and to identify the morally relevant features of a case that may occur in various nursing fields, including ethical issues confronting on the relationships between a nurse and a nursing client, between a nurse and a collaborator/colleague.

▶ **02881 Living EnglishIII**

This subject aims to learn English conversation skills with clients and apply nursing assessment, diagnosis and nursing intervention.

▶ **02465 Introduction to Social Welfare**

This subject studies academic research and practice in social welfare. So in this subject includes concept of social welfare, value and mission of social welfare, developmental process of social welfare, research of social welfare etc.

▶ **03179 Clinical Practicum for Integrating Nursing**

This subject cultivates the student's ability to practice caring for patients with health problem through the life-span in various clinical settings. It is composed of clinical practice in a medical-surgical, pediatric, gynecological, community-based psychiatric settings to treat patient's health problems in the nursing process

▶ **02886 Oriental Nursing**

This subject cultivates the student's ability to care for individuals with having wholistic basic needs in the oriental integrating approach. In this course, Students will acquire the knowledge and skill about oriental medical treatment, care of health, and complementary therapy.

► **02870 Introduction to Nursing Management**

This course, 02870 Introduction to Nursing Management, is designed to introduce the principles and practical knowledge of nursing administration to the students who will apply in a variety of health care organizations as well as community nursing fields as a preliminary nurse manager. This course presents nursing management theories, management environment related to nursing care, nursing management process including strategic planning, organizing, human resource management, leadership, quality management, customer relationship management in nursing and nursing marketing.

► **02871 Nursing Statistics**

This Subject is to study the statistics and measurement used in nursing field. Building on a basic understanding of statistics, students focus on application of statistical methods in research design, interpretation and utilization.
